ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

An applicant must be at least seventeen years of age upon completion of the cosmetology program and must be a high school graduate or its equivalent.

Applicants who have not completed high school must have a 2.0 GPA validated by an official transcript.

The application process includes the following documents which are required:

Official High School Transcript or equivalent,
Two letters of recommendation, and
Personal interview appointment.

Completion of Skills Assessment and Aptitude Tests with a 75% minimum grade (administered by the admissions officer)

To apply, schedule a personal interview appointment with the admissions officer.
